Ring with Turquoise - Heinrich Vogeler, 1907

The construction and the form of this ring are as simple as they can be. Four vertically and one horizontally running filaments hold the roughly cut, polished turquoise. This design was, for the time (1907), revolutionary, it has nothing to do with the elaborate, ornate designs of the Art Nouveau period, and already indicates the beginning of expressionism. The design was made for a client, it is however unknown if it was ever produced. As by all Vogeler remakes, this ring limited to 25 pieces.
