Silver Fruit Bowl - Josef Albers, 1924

Josef Albers created this fruit bowl in 1924 with two slightly different variations; the difference being the size of the wooden balls, which serve at the same time as feet and as holders of the glass plate. The one with the larger feet is produced in silver, in an edition limited to 100 pcs. The original is in the collection of The Museum of Modern Art, New York.
